While year to date expenses are below budget they are also below actual year to date income received by \$20,626, and we continue to be

current with paying our benevolences and bills.

Additional Capital Building Fund contributions of \$4,929, that are applied to further reduce the principal of our mortgage, were received bringing the year to date additional building fund contributions received to \$16,820. This congregation is truly blessed and thankful for all who have and continue to give so generously. Thanks be to God! Our current mortgage balance is \$1,212,004.

Budgeted/Projected Income \$608,932* Budgeted/Projected Expense \$628,942

Separate from and in addition to our budgeted church income, other financial gifts (less the additional Capital Building Fund contributions) totaling \$12,674 were received. These gifts are used for non-budged activities and expenses.
